Farm for Scotland's Future. The sterile prairies of Strathkelvin show clearly why Scottish agricultural subsidies need to be linked to nature-friendly farming, as hedgerow destruction and insecticide saturation eradicate biodiversity; tell MSPs now: www.scotlink.eaction.online/farming.

Support smallholder farmers. The UK is signing trade deals that require countries to stop farmers swapping or selling seeds privately, yet in Africa and Asia around 60 per cent of seeds are obtained in this way to keep costs down; petition: www.action.transform-trade.org/sharing-seeds-stop-upov.

End child poverty. The incoming First Minister has said he will make child poverty his number one priority; the first step must be an immediate above-inflation increase to the Scottish child payment so it reaches the £40 per week by the end of the parliament: www.cpag.org.uk/news.



Evangelisation Fund. From the sale of a diocesan property Archbishop Nolan established a £1 million fund to enable initiatives to form new creative ways to reach out and proclaim The Gospel. We are the first parish, apparently, to apply to the fund and we learned weeks ago that we've become the first to win a grant of £9,400! This will bolster 'Together we make Maryhill'. It will challenge us to discern more ways to engage those who no longer come, who have been hurt or have rejected faith. Especially, we want to work harder with and for our young adults.
