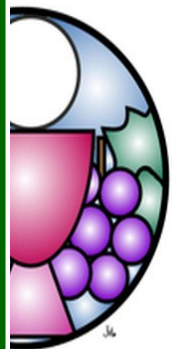
1st reading Proverbs 9: 1 - 6

Tuesday Club has started back - see you all from 11.30 - 2.30!

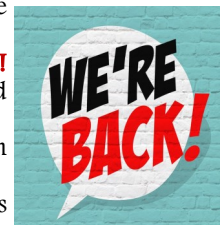
