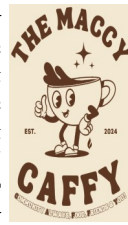

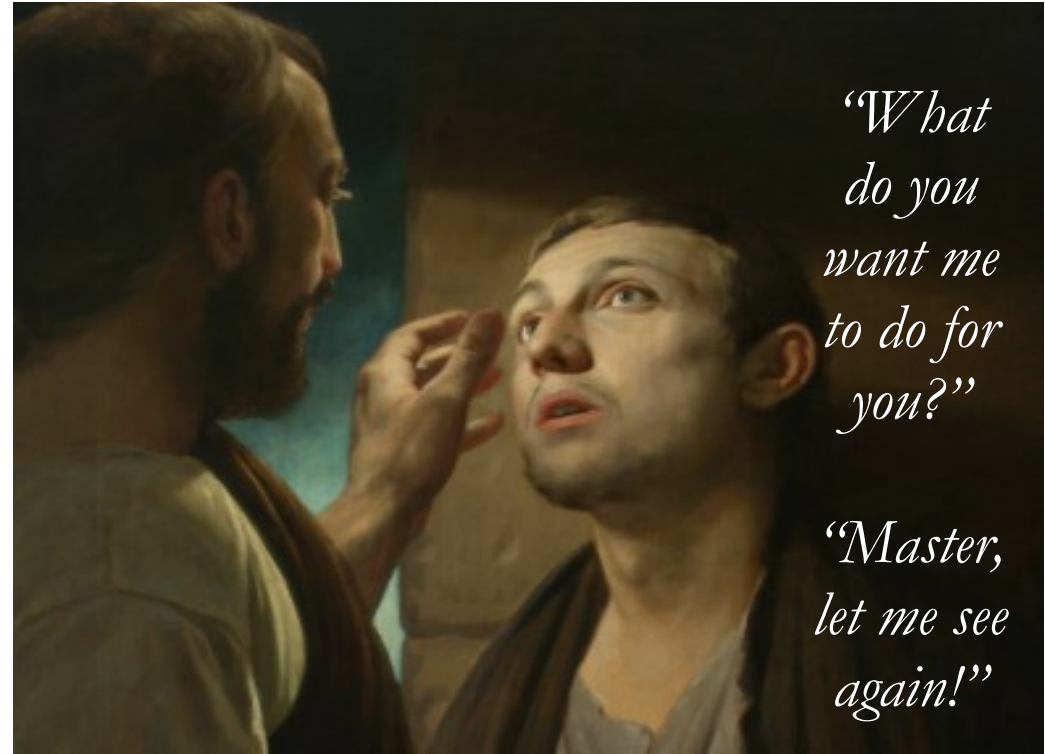
UNDER NEW MANAGEMENT
