Receiving Holy Communion. Some people are dipping the host in the chalice, a practice called intinction. This is not allowed in Scotland. Receive the host - consume it immediately; to receive the chalice, take it from minister, consume & return to be purified.

Eucharistic Ministers We either have people coming up who are not on or we have people not turning up when on rota. Please tick off your name, wear a lanyard, so we know you're here. Ministers should come to the altar immediately at the Lamb of God (not as it ends)
SPRED rooms Have been cleaned up, parts repainted and kitchen cleaned out. There is a new hard wearing non-slip flooring laid in the main room and new crockery and lighting. This came to just over £3,000!

(£9,700) Both gables need repointing & (defunct) chimneys blocked. (£12k) Ceiling on 3rd floor has come - water damage.

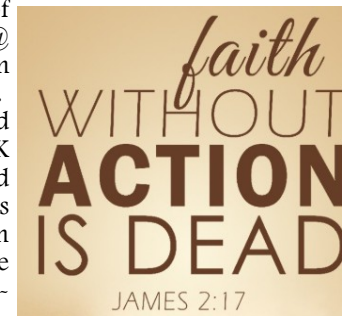
